THE PEACEMAKERS SIR KARL JENKINS CBE

The Peacemakers is a work extolling peace. One line, from Rumi (the 13th-century Persian mystic poet whose words I have set) sums up the ethos of the piece: 'All religions, all singing one song: Peace be with you'. Many of the 'contributors' are iconic figures that have shaped history, others are less well known. I have occasionally placed some text in a musical environment that helps identify their origin or culture; the bansuri (Indian flute) and tabla in the Gandhi, the shakuhachi (a Japanese flute associated with Zen Buddhism) and temple bells in that of the Dalai Lama, African percussion in the Mandela and echoes of the blues of the deep American South (as well as a quote from Schumann's Träumerei (Dreaming)) in my tribute to Martin Luther King. 'Healing Light: a Celtic prayer' is just that, with uilleann pipes and bodhrán drums. I have also presented some odd combinations, such as 'monastic chant meets the ethnic' in 'Let there be justice for all' and 'Inner peace'.

Having decided on The Peacemakers as the textual core and title of my new work the search was on to find messengers of peace. A handful of obvious figures came to mind, figures that have changed the world, such as Gandhi, Mandela and Martin Luther King, followed by such iconic and inspiring people as Mother Teresa and Anne Frank. Having sourced suitable and pithy text from these the net was cast to find other 'peacemakers'. I had been aware of Albert Schweitzer as a boy, in part because my organist father had recordings of him playing Bach, and I had previously set the Persian mystic poet, Rumi, in my Stabat Mater. I felt I needed something from the Abrahamic religions, so there are words from Christ, the Qur'an, Judaism and St Seraphim of Sarov (a Russian Orthodox monk), while St Francis of Assisi is included by association. I also quote from the Old Testament Book of Isaiah in my homage to Martin Luther King, as he did in his 'I have a dream' speech. English poets, Shelley and Malory are heard, as is Bahá'u'lláh, the founder of the Bahá'í faith. Carol Barratt added further text with the odd sentence from me. Some anonymous traditional text has also been included. I feel privileged that Terry Waite CBE has contributed some wonderful words, especially written for The Peacemakers.

MUSIC DIRECTOR - Jason Balla



Jason was born in Wales and was awarded the prestigious Organ Scholarship to Balliol College, Oxford where he also sang in the choir of New College. Jason sang and toured as a soloist with the National Youth Choir of Great Britain and at age eighteen he became the youngest member of the Academy of St. Martin-in-the-Fields in London. After completing post-graduate studies in voice and opera at The Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London Jason went on to a busy schedule internationally as a singer, pianist, organist and music director. As a conductor and choral trainer his choral repertoire ranges from masterworks of the renaissance through Handel oratorios and Mozart masses to 20th century English choral pieces.

As a teacher of music and voice in particular Jason has tutored and taught extensively in the UK and the USA. As a singer he appears regularly in opera, concert and oratorio throughout the UK, Europe, the Far East, and North America. He has performed most of the major concert and oratorio works, including Verdi's *Requiem*, Lloyd Webber's *Requiem*, Beethoven's *Ninth Symphony* and many others. He has recorded recitals of French and English music for Radio Hong Kong and has also been featured on CBC and BBC radio broadcasts, and CD recordings of Mozart's *Requiem* and Haydn's *Lord Nelson Mass* with the Slovak Philharmonic. Jason was a company member of the Lyric Opera of Chicago from 1995 to 2018. His organ and piano instrumental recital tours have taken him from the West Coast of the USA to Germany, the UK and the Far East. In 2021 Jason moved to Nelson where he now resides permanently.

ORGANIST - Simon Over



Simon Over studied at the Amsterdam Conservatoire, the Royal Academy of Music and Oxford University. It is worth noting that Simon, alongside our Music Director Jason Balla and NCC guest organist David Burchell were all recipients of prestigious Organ Scholarships at the University of Oxford at the same time during the 1980s.

Simon is the Founder-Conductor of the UK Parliament Choir and has conducted many performances with the City of London Sinfonia, London Festival Orchestra and Southbank Sinfonia which he founded in 2002. He has conducted many of its concerts throughout the UK, Europe and Asia.

In 2006 Simon was appointed Conductor of the Malcolm Sargent Festival Choir as well as being Music Director of Bury Court Opera conducting performances of *Dido and Aeneas, Rigoletto, La Cenerentola, Eugene Onegin, The Fairy Queen, The Rake's Progress* and *Madama Butterfly.* Further conducting credits include City Chamber Orchestra (Hong Kong), the Goyang Philharmonic Orchestra (Korea), and Vestfold International Festival in Norway.

Recently appointed Principal Guest Conductor of the Southern Sinfonia, New Zealand, in 2013 he conducted a joint concert with the Yamagata Symphony Orchestra and Southern Sinfonia, representing Australia and New Zealand in Tokyo's Asia Orchestra Week.



In addition to today's Choral PEACE concert the Choir has been invited by TimeDate, a Swiss consortium, to take part in a worldwide choral event to celebrate and promote World Peace Day. Under our Music Director, Jason Balla, we have leapt at the chance to sing to promote peace throughout the world. We know how blessed we are in Aotearoa New Zealand and would love to think that our tiny efforts might make a difference to others in very different circumstances.

On the International Day of Peace, the 21st of September 2023, the sound of 'The Peacemakers' by Karl Jenkins will circumnavigate the globe as a musical relay, starting with the Nelson Civic Choir. The musical message of peace then will be shaped by choirs on nearly all the continents.

The celebration for World Peace Day is scheduled to begin in Lucerne in Switzerland at 9.30am Central European Time (CET), which is 7.30pm NZ time. All the concerts participating across the world will be presented on the TimeDate website from 9.30am to 11.30pm CET, in a livestream, and will continue to be broadcast until October 31st.
